- The meet must be a closed YMCA meet.
- The meet must adhere to the *Rules that Govern YMCA Competitive Sports*.
- USA Swimming Technical Rules must be used.
- Only current certified YMCA Swim Officials will conduct the meet.
- Only coaches with current CPR, First Aid and Lifeguard/YASA/Safety Training for Swim Coaches certifications will be permitted on deck.
- All swimmers must be full privilege members of their YMCA and must have represented only their YMCA in competition (high school excepted) for a period of 90 days prior to the start of the meet.
- The meet must have entry standards.
- The meet must be: the highest level championship meet for a given region, an end-of-season meet at a higher level for a given region, or an invitational that includes competitors from multiple regions and with a level of competition higher than that offered in their region.

Copies of all YMCA Swim Officials certifications as indicated above

Copy of the meet information to be sent to participating teams
