2024-25 Team & Coach Registration

YMCA annual team and coach registration for the 2024-25 season begins September 1. Please do not submit registrations prior to September 1.

Team registration is \$50 per team. Coach registration is free until December 1. After December 1, coach registration is \$100 per coach.

YMCA team registration for the 2023-24 season yielded the following data:

- 532 teams registered
- There were a reported 56,892 Y swimmers
- There were a reported 358
 Full Time coaches, 2,397
 Part Time coaches and 326
 Volunteer coaches in Y
 programs
- 55.45% of Y teams are also registered with USA Swimming

THOUGHT LEADER COHORT OPPORTUNITY

YMCA Thought Leader Cohorts (TLCs) are working groups of Y staff from across the Movement who bring a mix of expertise, innovative and strategic thinking, imagination and creative problem solving. The Sports TLC will apply the Y's Innovation approach to solving critical issues for both recreational and competitive sports (swimming and gymnastics).

TLC meetings will occur monthly, primarily by video but will include some in-person meetings. Commitment is at least one year.

Y Swim Officials Training Update

The YMCA Swim Officials courses are still being revised, with an anticipated release by the end of 2024.

- Current courses and materials, including tests, will be used until the updates are released.
- All current trainers will be notified and given the opportunity to review the new courses. Trainers will complete a trainer acknowledgement prior to teaching the new material.
- Remember that current course tests use the 2022 Rulebook and are available through LCDC.
