2024-25 YMCA Swimming Season

Welcome to the new YMCA competitive swimming season! Whether you are new or well-tenured in your service to the YMCA and the Y swimming community, there are several ways to stay informed and connected.

- Annual Y team and coach registration This is for ALL teams and coaches. Team registration is \$50/year and coach registration is free until Dec. 1 and then includes a \$100/coach charge to your YMCA. These are also required for participation in all sanctioned Y meets. Registration link HERE.
- Team registration Provides valuable data on the size and scope of Y swimming in the U.S. Please review your team information and update annually. Make sure to update your officials coordinator, aquatics director and executive director.
- Coach registration Not only ensures all coaches are certified to be on deck, but national and regional communication is sent only to registered coaches and to aquatics directors indicated on the team registration.
